## **IQAC** Activities

#### **Staff Council Meet**

An annual staff council meet for the new academic session was held in the conference hall of the college. Keeping in view that change is a healthy practice for any institution to perform well, a major reshuffle in almost all the committees took place. #### **IQAC** Review Meet

The first IQAC Review Meet was convened by the Chairperson, Prof. (Dr) Maqsooda Khan. The meeting was attended by an external expert, community representative and all the IQAC members. During the course of meeting certain key issues pertaining to sustenance of quality and augmenting the campus infrastructure were discussed. The Esteemed Madam Principal informed the guests about the new subjects viz. Home Science, Hospitality and Catering Technology and the vocational courses of Boutique Technology and Paper Machie which were introduced in the college. She invited suggestions from the members for quality sustenance.

The external expert Dr. Nusrat Andrabi was presented with a copy of Action Taken Report (ATR), minutes of the meeting (IQAC Review Meet-2015) and a copy of the NAAC Peer Team Report. She stressed upon making the newly introduced courses to be made quality compliant. She also submitted a proposal to introduce Hindi as one of the subjects offered in the UG Course. Introduction of Honors courses in History, Urdu and English was also proposed by Dr. Andrabi. Keeping in view the catastrophe of the September Floods, she advocated on instructing girls in aquatic sports like boating to prepare them for life saving situations.

The community representative Mr. Tariq Ahmad suggested imparting Moral Education to students besides conducting inspection rounds outside and inside the campus by faculty members on daily basis. Further, he informed the august house that he would help in negotiating with the procurement of nearby building for Hostel accommodation as was one of the recommendation put forth by NAAC Team. # Admission under Credit Based Choice System (CBCS)

The college started online admission process in tune with UGC-CBCS-2016 scheme introduced by the University of Kashmir from the current session. The students were admitted afresh to the first semester of three year course under the said system.

The new system introduced provides core course plus open choice courses in which student will be taking skill/ability enhancement courses. Apart from being academically enriched CBCS will have skill courses to generate employment avenues for students. It allows a student to study a subject of her / his preference and interest. The system is based on semester pattern and entails awarding grades in place of marks. The number of permissible combinations of subjects under the above mentioned scheme in different streams and courses offered by the college are: Arts = 73; Medical = 12; Non-Medical = 05; B.Com = 03; BBA/Home Science = 01
