(ACTIVITY OF AWARENESS BY NSS AND RED RIBBON CLUB)

World AIDS Day, designated on 1 December every year since 1988 is an international day dedicated to raising awareness of the AIDS Pandemic caused by the spread of HIV Infection and mourning those who have died of the disease. In this direction the college NSS and Red Ribbon Club of the college organized an awareness programme regarding HIV Awareness on 1st December 2021 through lecture series in the college. The event was organized in smart class room of the college and more than 60 students of different streams attended the lecture series.

The programme was initiated by motivation speech of Principal Prof. Tabasum Rafiq to know about these diseases which have social stigma attached and delivered a Background note on AIDS (ACQUIRED IMMUNODEFICIENCY SYNDROME).
