A Brief Profile

The college is one of the premier institutions affiliated to Kashmir University and is situated right on the right bank of River Jhelum.

The main building complex of the college is located amongst a host of historical and religiously venerated sights ranging from mosques and temples to Sufi shrines and merchant sarais .

The college is 3.7km away from Lalchowk the district head quarters. Following establishment in the year 1961 on an area about 2400 sqmts, the college has been accredited twice. It has improved from Grade B to Grade A with 3.10 CGPA in the year 2015. The college has also privilege to be the only college of the valley Graded by NRF(R-Band-151-200).though due to paucity of space the college caters more than 2000 students every year. The college at present offers range of courses under various subjects under Choice Based Credit System at under graduate level in five streams –Science, Arts, Social Science, Commerce and Computer Science. At part from in his the college has now started Post Graduate courses in Commerce and Music. In addition IGNOU and Distant Education Centers present within the campus offer a wide range of under graduate/Post graduate courses for the aspiring students of adjoining areas. The college has the distinction having started the Skill Courses in Cutting Tailoring and Paper Machie, for the produce a shop has been allotted to the college in famous Exhibition grounds for the sale. Under RUSA Rashtra Uttachartar Siksha Abhiyan two vocational courses –Loan Approval Officer, Small and Medium Entrepreneur Officer have been started from the current academic session. As a part of outreach plan, J&K entrepreneurship development institute (JKEDI) in collaboration with placement cell of our college organized some awareness programmes on entrepreneurship development schemes. In the session several corporate /companies visited the college campus and organized placement cum consultancy drives under mission UDAAN. With the purpose to increase the accessibility of different scientific developments and researches, subject tours were organized by various departments of the college. As a social obligations the college financial aid committee provided financial assistance to as many as 400 students . In addition financial help was also provided via IQARA Students Welfare Fund (NGO) The preparations are at peak for the third cycle of NAAC Accreditation due in 2020.

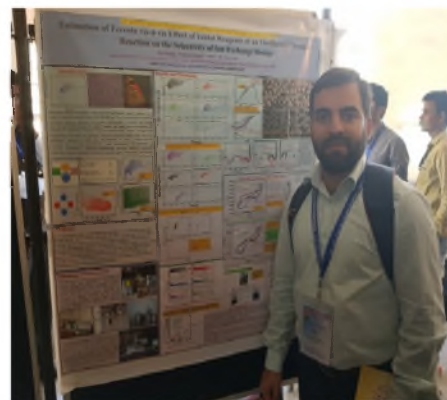

- The Academic Session started with enrolment of NCC Cadets. Allotted vacancies for our college were 16 and the allotted number has been enrolled.



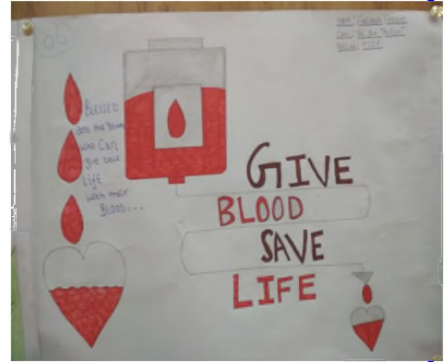

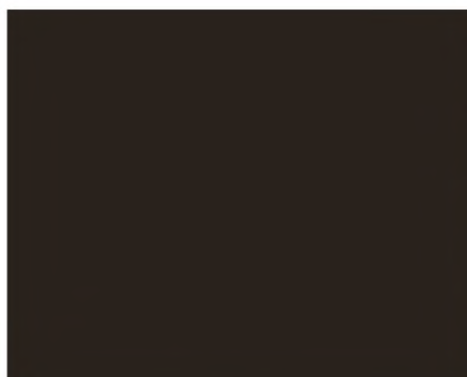


- NCC wing orga- nized cleanliness drive in college campus w.e.f 13th August, 2018 upto 20th August, 2018. The number of participants was 25.

Department of Geography The students of B.G 1st Semester, Department of Geography, conducted a day long subject field tour to Boot-Puthri Gulmarg on 17th Oct 2018. The mandatory field tour provided the students with the opportunity to explore the rich geographical and ecological diversity of the visited area. The students observed the pastoral life-style and socio-economic conditions of the population, particularly the



women, in the nearby hamlet. Dr. Aadil M. Nanda, the in-charge teacher, assisted the students to understand the impact of de-forestation and human exposure on the landuse/landcover pattern of the fragile ecosystem. The students were explained the process of meadow formation on the trip. Moreover, the students were given to understand a brief idea of flora and fauna in the area.

The Department of Chemistry took the students on Educational trip on 19th Sep-2018 to Bottaphatri which is rich in high altitude medicinal plants, in order to make them aware of the plant species which are having tremendous medicinal potential such plants have significant quantities of terpenes and terpenoides. (Essential oils) further the students also collected samples of different water bodies for analysis of dissolved oxygen, p.H, Sulphate and Phosphates.



The Department of Botany organized subject field study trip for Botany students of Ist, 2nd and 3rd semester to Naranag (Sonamarg) . At the outset, the students got an opportunity to visit the world famous trout fish farm. They got the knowhow about the rearing and financial aspect of the farm. A briefing on flora and fauna about the area was given to the students by subject experts accompanying them.

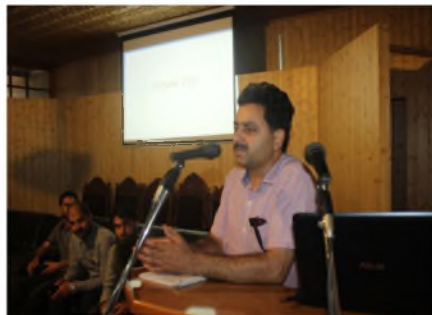

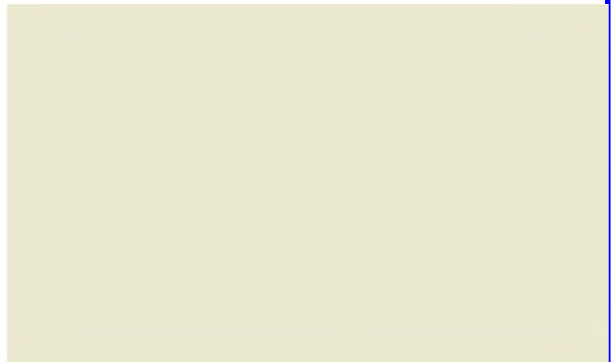
Inter college Judo Championship organized by University of Kashmir in which our college bagged 2 Silver medals.

- College playground smoothened after earth filling to make it fit for conduct of outdoor games.

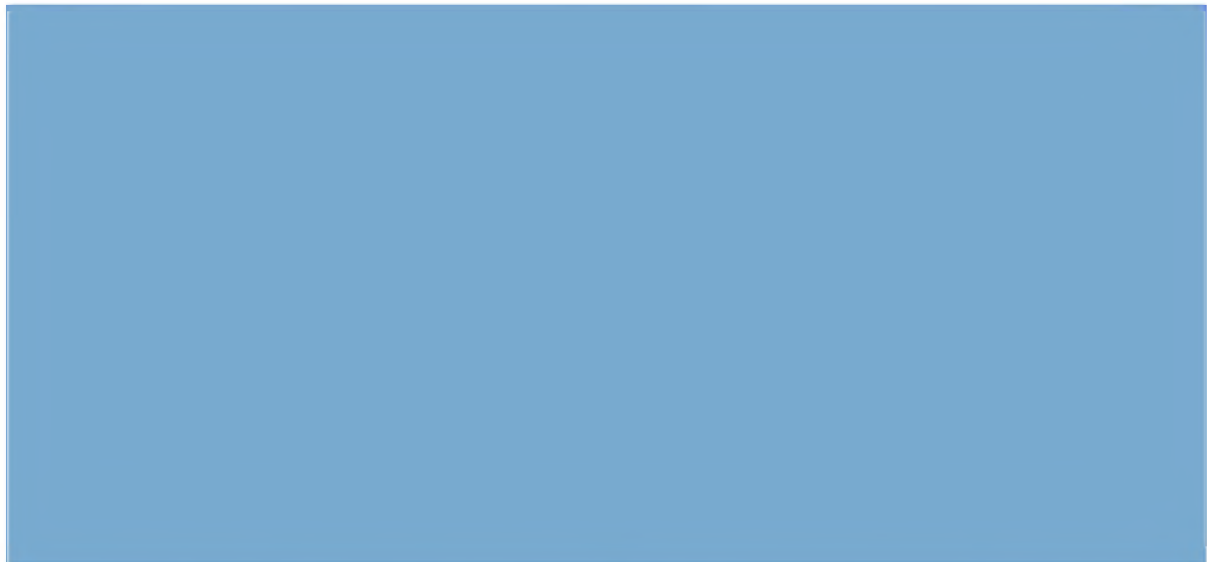
