College Profile

The Government College for Women, Nawakadal, situated on the Southern banks of river Jehlum is the only institution of Higher Education for Women ideally located in *Shehr- e -Khas* (Down Town area of Srinagar city). The institution is dedicated to excellence in the field of higher learning & committed to the cause of empowerment of women through the instrument of education. It was established in 1961 with Arts and Science subjects and a Teaching faculty of 19 members with just 50 students. 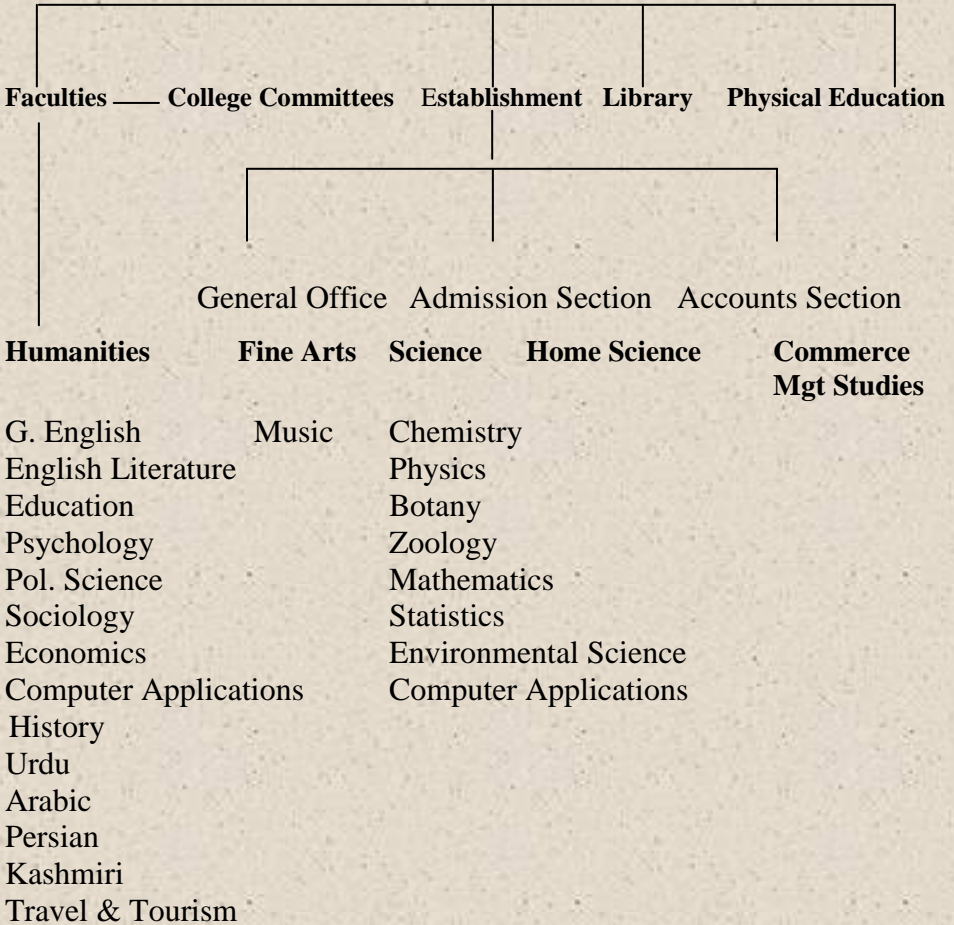
Expansion

Code of Conduct

Students seeking admission will have to observe the code of conduct set by the institution for its grace and dignity. The Code of conduct is given as under:-

- ✓ Students are not allowed to wear any jewellery (precious, semi-precious or artificial)
- ✓ Student are not allowed to carry mobile phones and cash alongwith them to the College.
- ✓ Students are not allowed to carry any objectionable material (kind or printed) in their Bags.
- ✓ Students are not allowed to invite or see their friends in the college campus.
- ✓ Students are not allowed to roam around the college unnecessarily during college time.



- ✓ Students are not allowed to use or carry polythene bags in the college campus.
- ✓ All the students are required to attend the morning assembly whenever held.
- ✓ Any student who fails to observe the above mentioned code of conduct is liable for cancellation of admission.

Dress Code:

All the students must attend the College dressed in the ***proper uniform*** (Description given as under)

- White kameez shalwar, white scarf / dupatta.
- Kameez / shirt length should be below knees.
- Simple black Abhaya (Veil) without highlighting (Embroidery) and black scarf with white dupatta / scarf.
- White kameez shalwar and blue summer coat for BBA students.
- Students wearing burqa (full Veil) are required to wear white scarf beneath black head gear.

Admission procedure

The admission to various courses is made in accordance with the rules & regulations laid down by the university of Kashmir/Higher Education Department from time to time. The admission shall be purely provisional and the college reserves the right to cancel the admission of any student at any stage if it is found that the student has furnished incorrect information or does not fulfil the eligibility criteria laid down by the University of Kashmir.

Identity Card

- No student shall be allowed to enter the campus without the valid identity card duly signed by the Principal/Deans

Attendance



- As per university statutes, all the students are directed to have 75% of attendance in all the subjects. The regularity and punctuality must be taken due care of.
- Any student who fails to attain the requisite attendance will not be allowed to sit in the examination.
- Any student who remains absent from the college for 10 days consecutively is liable to cancellation of admission without informing the student.
- Any student who remains away from the college for 10 days in a month at certain intervals will be struck off from the college rolls. However, such students can be re-admitted in the college on request from their parents as per the rules of the University and government.

Eligibility

Those candidates who have passed 12th class examination in full shall be eligible for admission. However, for **Science stream**, only such of the candidates having secured not less than 45% marks in case of open merit and 40% marks in case of reserved categories (In accordance with SRO issued by the state government from time to time) in aggregate shall be eligible.

Services available

LIBRARY

College has a well stocked library consisting of nearly sixty thousand books on Science, Humanities, Commerce and Management besides having a variety of periodicals/Journals on various subjects. The Book Bank facility is also available in the library for economically weak students. The routine Library services offered include circulation service, reference and information service, Xerox facility, Periodicals, CD-ROM browsing, Online access and Internet (Wi-fi) facility to the members. Moreover, students and members have access to 5000 E-Journals and E-Books through N-List. The service of OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) is also available to members and the students.

COMPUTER CENTRE

To meet the challenges of IT revolution, the college has a well equipped computer lab with latest software with internet connectivity.

EDU-SAT

The college has EDU-SAT CENTRE with its hub at Government College for Women, M.A Road, Srinagar. The lectures on a variety of academic aspects are delivered at its hub and the college students enrich their knowledge by attending the lectures through EDU-SAT.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Physical Education is extremely significant for overall development of students. The College provides facility for playing Cricket, Volley Ball, Badminton and Table Tennis. The students are trained for taking part in the Mountaineering, Trekking, Martial Arts (Thang-Ta), Road Race & Cycle Race. The College has a spacious Badminton Hall and a well equipped Table Tennis Hall. The Physical Education Department provides the students coaching and expertise for different sports activities



and prepares them to participate in local, state and national events. The College provides students the opportunity to use newly established Gym.

EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES

Besides offering quality teaching for academic pursuits, the college endeavours simultaneously, to expose the talent of the students by allowing them to participate in different educational activities like debates, seminars, symposia, conferences and workshops. The college has bagged many Distinctions and Awards. The College has a capacious and well maintained auditorium & a well equipped Conference Hall.
