A Brief Profile

The Government College for Women, Nawakadal is one of the premier institutions affiliated to Kashmir University and is situated along the picturesque bank of River Jhelum.

The College is located at a place which is culturally and historically significant. The place is a host to various historical and religiously venerated sites ranging from mosques and temples to Sufi shrines and merchant sarais.

The college is 3.7km away from Lalchowk in Srinagar. Following its establishment in the year 1961 on an area about 2400 sqmts, the college has been NAAC accredited twice. It has improved from Grade B to Grade A with 3.10 CGPA in the year 2015. The college has also the privilege to be the only college in the valley Graded by NIRF(R-Band-151-200) in 2017. In spite of a paucity of space, the college caters to more than 1500 students every year. The college at present offers a range of courses under Choice Based Credit System at under graduate level in seven streams –Science, Arts, Social Science, Home Science, Management, Commerce and Computer Science..

The College is now offering PG courses in Commerce (M.Com.) & Management Studies (M.B.A) and will be introducing two more PG programmes viz. M.Sc. In Chemistry and MA in Music, all with University of Kashmir, which is also the affiliating university for UG courses. The college has the distinction of offering five skill courses under UGC- National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) which include Dress making, fitness management, Hospitality and Catering, web designing and Beautician courses. These courses aim to contribute to India's economy by providing employment opportunities to students. Besides IIC, Add-On Courses college is offering three UGC sponsored Add-On Courses viz.. Dying Technology, Data Care Management and Video Editing since-2009.

The college has also been recognised as Social Entrepreneurship, Swachhta and Rural Engagement Cell (SESREC) Institution. The college has the privilege of launching Industrial Skill Courses on Computer Concept (CCC) in collaboration with NIELIT Srinagar. As a social obligation, the college financial Assistance Committee provided financial assistance to deserving students of the college.

The college got registered with MoE innovation cell and there is a functional institution council (IIC) since 2020.

During the Covid-19 pandemic and subsequent lockdown, the whole educational system collapsed not only in India but across the globe. In the UT of Jammu & Kashmir, the situation was more worse following the restriction of internet to 2G only that affected education sector the most. Despite all these odds, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college displayed managerial acumen by flawlessly planning, organising and executing various curricular, co-curricular, extra –curricular and administrative activities through well organised delivery system.

The IQAC worked tirelessly for the preparation of Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) and their subsequent submission to NAAC. Activity Report Of Placement Cell And Career Counselling Cell

- **Internship** is an excellent way to supplement the theoretical knowledge acquired by students through classroom teaching. It offers an opportunity for students to implement their conceptual knowledge in actual work atmosphere. Considering the importance of internship programmes, under the initiative of Higher Education AICTE arranged special internship for the students of J&K in IITs and other leading institutions of the country. Our college utilized this opportunity and three of our students were selected for internship under this programme which included Seerat Mushtaq of B.A 3rd semester (selected in IIT Ropar), Iflah Javid of B.B.A 3rd semester (selected in IIT Guwahati) and Mehvish Hameed of B.B.A 5th semester (selected in IIT Ropar). The students of the college participated in Online Career Summit 2020 (31st Oct- 1st Nov) organized by NIT Srinagar. The event was aimed to give comprehensive guidance and information to students about career development and also to sensitize them about opportunities available at global level.
 - Students also participated in an online event regarding Startup Counseling on 15th November 2020. The event was organised by IIEDC(The Innovation Incubation and Entrepreneurship development Centre), NIT Srinagar and the speaker was an expert from JKEDI.

Institution Innovation Council (IIC)

The college has established Institution Innovation Council (IIC) registered with Ministry of Education's (MoE's) Innovation Cell during Calendar year-2020.





Skill Development Programmes

The National Skill Qualifications Framework (UGC-NSQF)

The University Grants Commission (UGC) has launched a scheme on skill development based higher education as part of college/university education, leading to Bachelor of Vocation (B.Voc.) degree with multiple exits such as Certificate/Diploma/Advanced Diploma under the NSQF (National Skills Qualifications framework). The skill programme focuses on providing undergraduate studies which would also incorporate specific job roles along with broad based general education. This would provide employment opportunities to students and would thus contribute to the growth of India's economy.

The University Grants Commission (UGC) has given a nod to five skill courses under National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) to the Govt. College for Women, Nawakadal, in 2020. These include Dress Making, Fitness Management, Hospitality and Catering, Web Designing and Beautician courses. The students need to be at least 10+2 qualified. The college has started enrolment for the same.

1.Diploma in Dress Making:

The main aim of dress designing is to develop an understanding of elements & principles of design and to acquaint the students with advanced techniques of designing and pattern making for different styles of clothing. The course is designed in such a way that it ensures that students have adequate knowledge and skills so that they are ready to work at the exit point of the course. Duration of the course is one year (Two semesters)

2.Diploma Course in Fitness Management:

Fitness management is an interdisciplinary field that blends scientific knowledge of exercise physiology and fitness studies with practical business skills. This course is especially developed to provide the individual a blend knowledge of fitness education and business principles in order to effectively serve, motivate, and counsel diverse clients. The aim of the course is to train young girls to be effective fitness trainers and to provide opportunity to the young girls to supplement household income and enter the workforce. Duration of the course is one year (Two semesters)

3.Certificate Course in Hospitality & Catering:

The "Certificate Course in Hospitality & Catering" is a judicious mix of skills, professional education related to Software Development Business and also appropriate content of general education. It is designed with the objective of equipping the students to cope with the emerging trends and challenges in the Software Development business environment. The duration of the Certificate Course in Hospitality & Catering shall be of one semester. The duration of each semester shall be five months inclusive of the days of examinations.

4.The Certificate Course in Web Designing:

The Certificate Course in Web Designing aims to groom the students to enable them to work on current web technology scenarios as well as prepare them to keep pace with the changing face of technology and the requirements of the growing IT industry. After the completion of the course, students can work as Web Developer / Web Designer / IT Support staff. Both theory and analytics skills are acquired from this qualification, so that the student may upgrade them by taking further course on advance web designing. Duration of the course is 6 Months.

5. Certificate Course in Beautician:

The beauty therapy industry helps people look and feel their best. Beauty therapy courses will give training to the young, aspiring professionals of this vast and dynamic field thereby providing them with the experience and knowledge necessary to build a career in this field. After completion of this course, the students can join world-class beautician courses that will give a better chance of success in the massive beauty industry. Duration of the course is 6 Months.
