#### A Brief Profile

The Government College for Women, Nawakadal is one of the premier institutions affiliated to Kashmir University and is situated along the picturesque bank of River Jhelum.

The College is located at a place which is culturally and historically significant. The place is a host to various historical and religiously venerated sites ranging from mosques and temples to Sufi shrines and merchant sarais.

The college is 3.7 km away from Lalchowk in Srinagar. Following its establishment in the year 1961 on an area of about 2400 square me-



ters, the college has been NAAC accredited twice. It has improved from Grade B to Grade A with 3.10 CGPA in the year 2015. In spite of a paucity of space, the college caters to more than 1500 students every year. The college at present offers a range of courses under Choice Based Credit System at under graduate level in seven streams –Science, Arts, Social Studies, Home Science, Management Studies, Commerce and Computer Science. Besides undergraduate courses, the college also offers PG courses in Commerce (M.Com.), Management Studies (M.B.A) and Chemistry (M. Sc). These courses aim to contribute to India's economy by enriching human resource of the country.

The college has successfully started admissions for the new batch of 2022 under the guidelines of new Education Policy (NEP–2020). With this new framework the college mainly aims at fulfilling the motto of the NEP, that is to, "Educate Encourage Enlighten" the students by empowering them with academic choice, multiple exit points and diverse areas of study.

The second-half of the year 2022 was remarkably productive and fruitful for the college in myriad ways. The college succeeded in getting AICTE approval for the prestigious MBA programme after an arduous journey of 2 years. Besides, the college managed to get approval for two research projects in Chemistry. The college also got registered with SWAYAM NPTEL Local Chapter and a separate web page of the institution was also created. As the college is also registered with MoE innovation cell, it has a functional institution Council (IIC) since 2020.

The college has got about two star Ratings in the performance Report generated for Q1 & Q2 for Institution Innovation Council by AICTE Ministry of Education Innovation Cell Government of India.

Besides the college was also ranked as a Band Performer throughout India in 2021 in ARIA ranking.





## Lecture on "Consumer Behavior and Factors"



Prof.Hafizullah, Head, Department of Political Science talked about International Human Solidarity Day.




## 21st December, 2022

#### **Ideathon 2022**



It was observed that there was a poor recognition level of the early stages of eye disease amongst some low income population. The screening camp medical team identified people in the community who were suffering from any form of eye disease. The findings ranged between the following; corneal opacity, vision, Cataract, Retinal Pathology and Glaucoma. 320 beneficiaries attended the camp. 90 were provided with near vision spectacles and another 40 beneficiaries were provided with distance spectacles.
