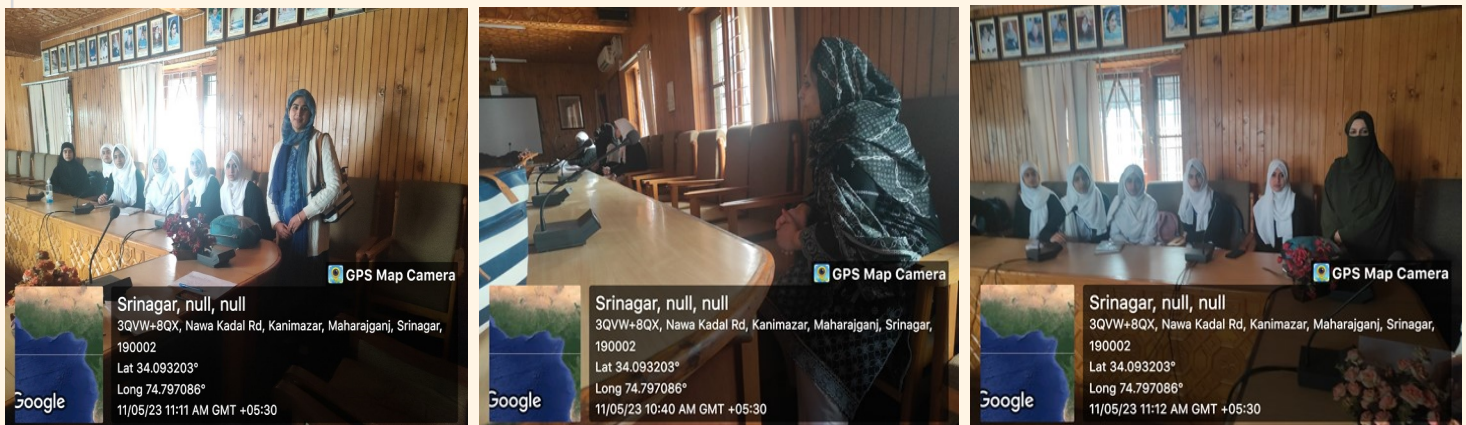
6th May 2023**Department of Psychology**

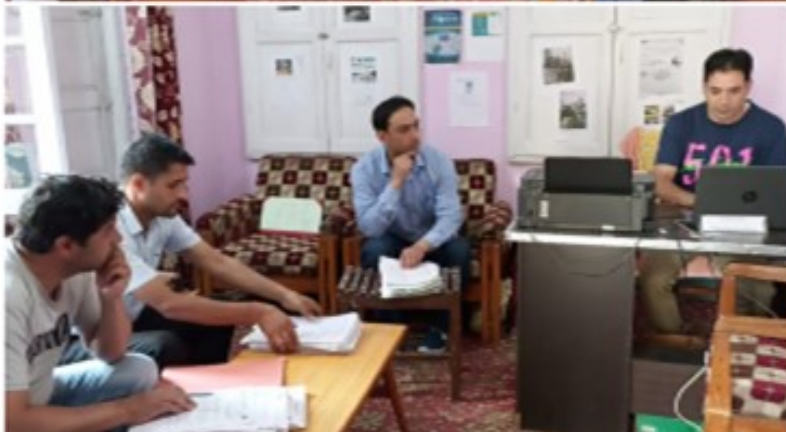

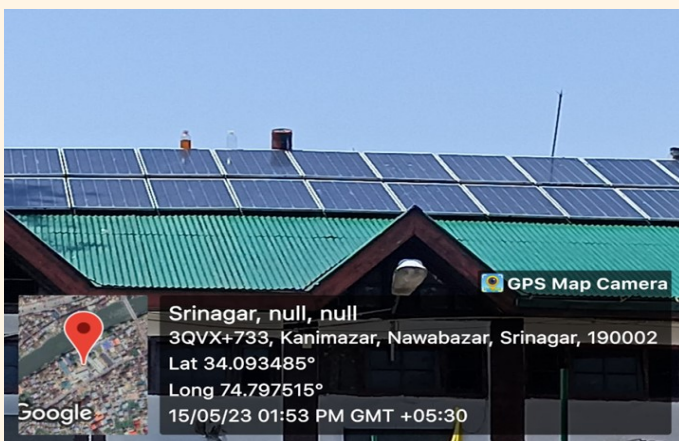

The Inaugural match was played between Team YELLOW and Team GREEN in which later emerged as winners with a score of 8-2 and entered into the finals .

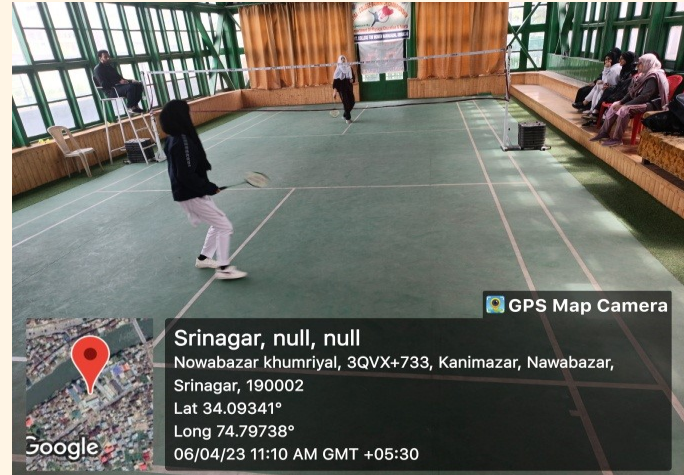

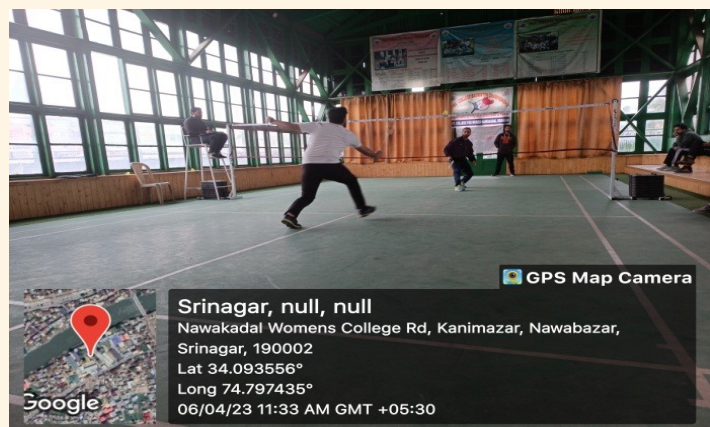
5th to 11th April, 2023**INTRA-COLLEGE BADMINTON TOURNAMENT FOR BOYS & GIRLS -2023**
